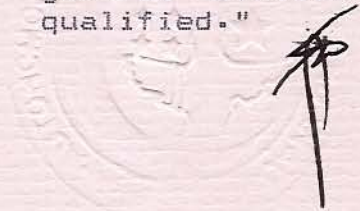
[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 41]

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION FOUR OF MUSLIM
MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 36,
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly
in session assembled:


SECTION 1. Section Four of Muslim Mindanao
Autonomy Act No. 36 is hereby amended, in part, to read
as follows:

"The Commission on Elections shall conduct and
supervise the plebiscite, which shall be held within
thirty (30) days after the approval of this amendment or
to such reasonable date as the Commission on Elections
may determine. Upon ratification by the majority of
votes cast in the plebiscite held in the areas affected,
the Regional Governor of the Autonomous Region in Muslim
Mindanao shall appoint the Mayor, Vice-Mayor, and Members
of the Sangguniang Bayan of the new municipality of
Sultan Dumalondong who shall hold office until their
successors shall have been duly elected in the next
general elections for local officials and shall have
qualified."




SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


