[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 126]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand and one.

AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS ONE AND TWO
OF MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY
ACT NUMBER ONE HUNDRED
THIRTEEN AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.”

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Section one of Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act Number One Hundred Thirteen is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

“The Sitio of Istambak_ is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Istambak out of the existing mother Barangay Sionogan in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu”.

SEC. 2 . Section two thereof is hereby likewise amended, to read as follows:

The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Istambak is defined by the following description:


“Beginning at a point marked 1-2 thence bearing N48°00E, 3,417.82m, along line 2-3 bearing S21°50'E, 1,164 m, along line 3-4 bearing S35°48'W, 3,560 m, along line 4-1 bearing N27°54'W, 1,902 m, closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
