**THIRD LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
(Sixth Regular Session)**

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 131]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday the twenty-third day of April, two thousand and one.

**“AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS ONE AND TWO OF
MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT
NUMBER ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”**

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Section one of Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act Number One Hundred Eighteen is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

“The Sitios of Kayam Dakula, Kaumman Jati, Kan Buclao, Sapah Ji-nan, Lahmagan, Bad-bad and Tubig Pangi is hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay to be known as Barangay Bakud out of the existing mother barangay Kagay in the Municipality of Indanan, Province of Sulu.

SEC. 2 . Section two thereof is hereby likewise amended, to read as follows:

The territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Bakud is defined by the following description:

“Beginning at a point marked 1-2 thence bearing N17°20'W, 3,494 m, along line 2-3 bearing N72°15'E, 1,700 m, along line 3-4 bearing S14°05'E 3,430 m, along line 4-1 bearing S69°30'W, 1,500 m, closing the traverse and going back to the point of origin.


SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
