ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 143

AMENDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 121 DATED JUNE 22, 1955, ENTITLED
"CREATING A TRAINING COORDINATION COUNCIL TO COORDINATE AND
FACILITATE THE IN-SERVICE TRAINING ACTIVITIES OF THE DIFFERENT
OFFICES OF THE GOVERNMENT."


The first and second paragraphs of Administrative Order No. 121
dated June 22, 1955, are hereby amended to read as follows:

"A Training Coordination Council is hereby created to coordinate
and facilitate, in accordance with such policies as the Government
Advisory Board for In-Service Training may adopt, the in-service
training activities of the different departments, bureaus and offices
of the government, and to determine, in conformity with procedures
which the Institute of Public Administration, University of the Phil-
ippines, may prescribe, the specific training requirements of said
offices as basis for developing and carrying out their respective
in-service training programs.

"The Council shall be composed of the Administrative Officer
of the Department of Education, as Chairman, and the administrative
officers of the other departments, the Office of the President and
the General Auditing Office, and the Director of Training of the
City of Manila, as members."

Done in the City of Manila, this 10th day of October,
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, and of
the Independence of the Philippines, the tenth.
