ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 252

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ALLEGED ANOMALIES IN ALL
SETTLEMENTS OF THE NATIONAL RESETTLEMENT AND REHABILITA-
TION ADMINISTRATION.

A committee is hereby created to investigate alleged anomalies
in all settlements of the National Resettlement and Rehabilitation
Administration, composed of the following:

- A representative of the Solicitor General Chairman
- A representative of the Judge Advocate
General, Armed Forces of the Philippines Member
- A representative of the Secretary of
Agriculture and Natural Resources "
- A representative of the Auditor General "
- A representative of the Director, National
Bureau of Investigation "

For the purpose of the investigation, the committee is hereby
granted all the powers of an investigating committee under Sections
71 and 580 of the Revised Administrative Code, including the power
to summon witnesses, administer oaths, and take testimony or evidence
relevant to the investigation. The committee is also empowered and
authorized to call upon any department, bureau, office, agency or
instrumentality of the Government for such information as it may
require in the performance of its work, and, for the purpose of
securing such information, it shall have access to, and the right
to examine, any books, documents, papers, or records thereof.

The committee shall submit its report and recommendations
to the President of the Philippines as soon as possible.

the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and of
the Independence of the Philippines, the twelfth.
