
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 63

AMENDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 51 DATED MAY 4, 1967,
CREATING A COMMITTEE TO PASS UPON AND COORDINATE
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RADIO STATIONS AND ISSUANCE
OF RADIO FREQUENCIES.
