EXECUTIVE ORDER }  
No. 92. }

Executive Order Numbered Twenty-nine, current series, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Manuel Tinio, Director of Lands, Vicente Losada, Delegate to the Philippine Assembly from the Sixth Assembly District of the Province of Cebu, and Frank W. Carpenter, Executive Secretary, are hereby constituted a committee to be known as the Board on Agricultural Colonies. The board will proceed as speedily as practicable to formulate and submit to the Governor-General a plan for carrying into effect the purposes of Act Numbered Twenty-two hundred and fifty-four; and will perform such other duties in connection therewith as shall be indicated from time to time by the Chief Executive.

“The Director of Lands is designated the representative of the Governor-General as contemplated by section four of said Act.”
