PROCLAMATION NO. 111

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 19, 1966, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC
HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD.

WHEREAS, the twenty-eighth anniversary of the
organization of the City of Bacolod falls on October 19,
1966; and

WHEREAS, the people of said city request that they
be given full opportunity to celebrate the event with
appropriate ceremonies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President
of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested in
me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do
hereby declare Wednesday, October 19, 1966, as a special
public holiday in the City of Bacolod.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 14th day of October,
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
