PROCLAMATION NO. 262

DECLARING TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 1967, AS LAW DAY.

WHEREAS, the administration of justice is indispensable to a sound and vigorous democracy;

WHEREAS, lawyers play an important role in the administration of justice and in enhancing the rule of law in our democratic society; and

WHEREAS, it is but fitting that such a vital role of lawyers in the life and well-being of the nation be duly brought to the attention of our people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Tuesday, September 19, 1967, as Law Day. I urge the various bar and lawyers' association to celebrate the day with appropriate ceremonies.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 8th day of September, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
