PROCLAMATION NO. 289

RESERVING FOR MILITARY PURPOSES A PARCEL OF LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED IN LAMAO, MUNICIPALITY OF LINAY, BATAAN PROVINCE, ISLAND OF LUZON.

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and pursuant to the power vested in me by law, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby exclude from the operation of Executive Order No. 48, s. 1919, which reserved a parcel of land of the public domain in Lamao, Linay, Bataan, for horticultural experiment station site purposes, and reserve for military purposes, subject to private rights, if any there be, under the administration of the Secretary of National Defense, the following parcel of land of the public domain, containing an area of approximately TWO MILLION SIX HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND (2,630,000) Square Meters, more or less, which parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

From point 1 which is equal to corner 18 of the Industrial Estate Corporation established under Proclamation No. 361 dated March 6, 1968,

distance S 16° 50'W.,	1,877.50 M	to point 2;
S 39° 51'W.,	597.43 M	to point 3;
S 36° 19'W.,	765.16 M	to point 4;
N 0° 07'W.,	80.70 M	to point 5;
N 0° 07'W.,	329.07 M	to point 6;
N 0° 15'E.,	197.20 M	to point 7;
N 70° 25'W.,	574.90 M	to point 8;
N 29° 15'E.,	90.00 M	to point 9;
S 85° 15'W.,	520.00 M	to point 10;
due North	1,362.63 M	to point 11;

along Ayer River from the point of beginning; containing an approximate area of TWO MILLION SIX HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND (2,630,000) square meters, more or less. Subject to future survey.
