DECLARING FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 1986, AS A NON-WORKING  
SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF CAVITE

WHEREAS, September 12, 1986 marks the 90th Death  
Anniversary of the XIII Martyrs;


WHEREAS, September 12, 1986 falls within the "Linggo ng

appropriate ceremonies.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, CORAZON C. AQUINO, President
