BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

PROCLAMATION NO. 823

DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC CALAMITY IN CERTAIN PROVINCES AND CITIES
IN REGIONS I, II AND THE CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION WHICH
SUFFERED FROM THE EFFECTS OF TYPHOON "TRINING."

WHEREAS, super typhoon with code name "Trining" wrought destruction
in the country, particularly Northern Luzon;

WHEREAS, initial reports revealed that 15,222 families or 84,732
persons were affected, 7,628 houses were damaged, including agricultural
crops and infrastructure valued at ₱25,171,675.00 and ₱5,800,000.00, res-
pectively; and

WHEREAS, in order to cushion the adverse impact of the typhoon,
the National Disaster Coordinating Council recommends the declaration
of a state of public calamity in the affected areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CORRAZON C. AQUINO, President of the Philippines,
by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare a state of
public calamity in the following provinces and cities:

All departments and other government agencies concerned are hereby
directed to implement and execute relief and rehabilitation work in
accordance with existing operational plans and the directive and order
issued in connection with calamities.
