BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

PROCLAMATION NO. 565

DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY TN THE PROVINCE OF SOUTH COTABATO WHICH WAS ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY THE LONG DRY SPELL

WHEREAS, the Secretary of National Defense and Chairman the National Disaster Coordinating Council recommends the declaration of a state of calamity province of South Cotabato in view of the long dry that has severely affected a considerable number of farmers and even local consumers in the said province;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for the declaration of a state of calamity in the area in order that the province may make use of its calamity fund for the relief and other emergency requirements of the affected constituents;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare that a state of public calamity exists in the province of South Cotabato.

Ill departments and other government agencies concerned mereby directed to implement and execute relief abilitation work in accordance with existing operational ns, directives and orders issued in connection
