WHEREAS, Monday, August 30, 2004, marks the 35th *Charter Day* anniversary of the City of Mandaue;


WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of the City of Mandaue be given full opportunity to celebrate this milestone in their city's history with appropriate ceremonies.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


