PROCLAMATION NO. 658

DECLARING TUESDAY, 15 OCTOBER 2013, AS A REGULAR HOLIDAY  
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, IN OBSERVANCE OF *EIDUL*  
*ADHA* (FEAST OF SACRIFICE)

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9849 provides that *Eidul Adha* shall be  
celebrated as a regular holiday;

**WHEREAS**, *Eidul Adha* is one of the two greatest feasts of Islam;

**WHEREAS**, the date of the festival is based on the declaration made  
by Saudi Arabia's highest religious body;

**WHEREAS**, the National Commission on Muslim Filipinos (NCMF)  
recommended that the observance of *Eidul Adha* be on 15 October 2013 and  
the *Eidul Adha* prayer be performed on the final declaration of the Kingdom of  
Saudi Arabia;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, President of the  
Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare  
Tuesday, 15 October 2013, as a regular holiday throughout the country, in  
observance of *Eidul Adha* (Feast of Sacrifice).

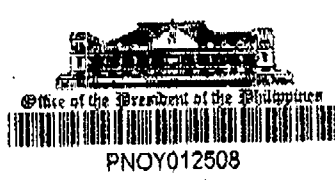
**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the
