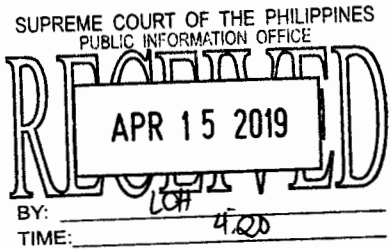


Please take notice that the Court, First Division, issued a Resolution dated March 4, 2019 which reads as follows:
