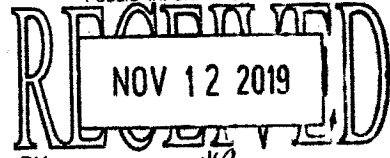


Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Court en banc issued a Resolution dated **OCTOBER 1, 2019**, which reads as follows:*

“G.R. No. 248935 (Virgilio A. Bote vs. Commission on Elections and Aurelio M. Umali).- In accordance with Rule 64 and other related provisions of the 1997 Rules of Civil Procedure, as amended, as well as circulars, directives or orders of the Supreme Court, governing review of judgments and final orders or resolutions of the Commission on Elections, only petitions which are accompanied by or which comply strictly with the requirements specified therein shall be entertained. On the basis thereof, the Court Resolved to **DISMISS** the instant petition for *certiorari* for non-compliance therewith, particularly for late filing.

In any event, the petition would still be dismissed for failure to sufficiently show that any grave abuse of discretion was committed by the Commission on Elections in rendering the challenged resolutions which, on the contrary, appear to be in accord with the facts and applicable law and jurisprudence.” Carandang, J., on official leave.
